Next, the Committee Reviewed and Approve Meeting Minutes from 03.24.2022.

Next, the Committee received an update on the Lawrence REALTORS[®] Community Foundation from Kate White, 2022 Chairperson. The LRCF had a successful fundraiser with Envista and the EnvistaCares Campaign.
